In 1977 he graduated from the Budapest University of Technology as an electrical engineer, then in 1982 he received his patent agent certificate from the ELTE Institute for Postgraduate Legal Studies. He is an associate at the Eötvös Lóránd Geophysical Institute of Hungary until 1987, where he takes part in multiple international expeditions as a software developer, alongside being one of the leaders of the software copywrite committee of the institute. Following that, he joins Graphisoft, first as a software developer, then working in different commercial positions. Between 1990-93 he directs the distribution of Apple in Hungary as a founder director. Next, he started working in the international sales of ArchiCad, from 1997 he leads Graphisoft's subsidiary in Hongkong for two years. Returning home, he becomes the company's commercial manager, he directs the international distribution network of ArchiCad, and also until 2003 manages the commerce of Graphisoft's property management softwares. Following that, he's an independent advisor for multiple IT companies, then in 2005 he joins as a co-owner vintoCon Kft. (which is a spin-off company of Graphisoft's branch that develops property management software), where he leads the company's commercial activities. Between 2010-12 he lectures at Corvinus University, and he is also a member of the Graphisoft Foundation for Hungarian Mathematics Education.
