Gábor Bojár physicist, founder of Graphisoft software development company, created in 1982. Under his leadership, Graphisoft developed into the leading architectural design software company of the world; its main product, ArchiCad, is used by more than 300 000 architects and professionals of the building industry in nearly 100 countries across the world. From 1998, the business was listed on the Frankfurt-, and from 2000 on the Budapest Stock Exchange, up until 2007, when it merged into the Germany-based Nemetschek Group. His work has been awarded among else with the Széchenyi Prize, the Order of Merit of the Republic of Hungary and the Ernst & Young Entrepreneur of the Year Award, furthermore he presented on multiple occasions at the annual World Economic Forum in Davos. Between 1995 and 2008 he was member of the board of directors of Gedeon Richter Plc., and between 2012 and 2016 he was member of the Governing Board of the European Institute of Innovation and Technology (EIT), elected by the European Commission. Since Graphisoft SE software company and Graphisoft Park SE real estate company separated in 2006, he serves as the president of the board of directors of both enterprises, moreover he is also presently the leader of the Acquincum Institute of Technology (AIT), a private university founded by himself.
