



Sándor BIHARI

Sándor Bihari graduated at the finance faculty of the Budapest University of Economics in 1991. The change in the political system of Hungary gave many opportunities for young professionals with knowledge of finance and accounting, and English language. Sándor could take the opportunities, and having spent two years in the corporate sector, he became the CFO of Graphisoft Trading Ltd. (later Hungarian Data Systems) from 1993 to 1995.

Between 1995 and 2008 Sándor Bihari was the CFO of Graphisoft SE software development group, playing key role in the company's first venture capital investment coming from Japan, as well as in the listing of the company on the Frankfurt Stock Exchange (1998) and on the Budapest Stock Exchange (2000). He also conducted the demerger of Graphisoft Park SE, as separate real estate development company from software development group and the listing of the company on the Budapest Stock Exchange. Finally, he also played key role in the merger of the software development company into Nemetschek AG based in Germany. After leaving Graphisoft SE, among others he was the CFO of Aeroplex of Central Europe Aircraft Technology Center Kft. (2008-2011) and Entry Point Central Kft. (2011-2017), later he worked as CEO at Entry Point Central Kft. between 2017 and 2020.

Sándor serves as CFO and investor relations manager of Graphisoft Park SE from July 1, 2020.
